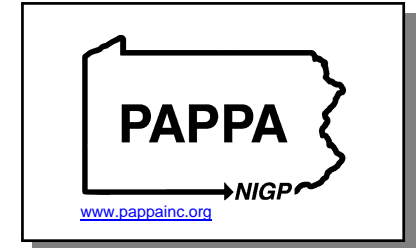
MISSION STATEMENT
